Newsletter TANDEM 5 – April 2022

What have we been working on?



On the 30th and 31st of March 2022, the partners of the TANDEM project met again online for the 4th Transnational Partner Meeting. The meeting lasted 2 days and focused mainly on the MOOC on Task-based Language Teaching (TBLT). This MOOC has been developed and tested in the last year, and now needs to be finalized based on the feedback of trainers and participants who have been involved in the testing activities. During the first day, all partners presented their experiences of the training activities with migrants and the language cafés in each country, bringing forward lessons learned, difficulties and success stories. During the second day, the partners worked together to list the difficulties and successes they encountered during the implementation of activities, and what needs to be changed in the MOOC in order to respond better to the needs and interests of the participants. An interesting outcome of the piloting in all countries was the interest of existing language teachers (both local and foreigners) in the MOOC on TBLT. The MOOC will therefore be adapted to different levels of learners and previous knowledge, including many optional topics for further research and resources.

Other topics that were discussed during the meeting included the improvement of assessment and validation tools, as well as the organization of the 2 multiplier events in each country, and the final event in Germany.

The TANDEM project continues until July 2022

The TANDEM project has been extended! The project will end by the end of July, enabling partners to implement local events to spread the word about the TANDEM project, and finalize the main results of the project, e.g. the MOOC and TBLT, a hand-out on cultural and language exchanges, and a framework for skills screening, monitoring and validation of skills acquired through non-formal learning.

The impact of the TANDEM project activities

In the last 6 months, the partners of the TANDEM project have been organizing training activities in each country, which included a training for migrants who want to learn how to teach their mother language and fun language exchanges to put TBLT into practice. This has been done in an online form or face-to-face, in language schools, refugee camps and in partners' offices. In each country, between 10 and 23 migrants have been participating in the activities, coming from very different backgrounds in terms of education, countries and future aspirations. This is what they had to say about the TANDEM training and MOOC on Task-Based Language Teaching:

 - Inspiring training showing new possible job opportunities (motivation to take your fate in your own hands)

 - o New digital skills and first experiences with self-study
 - o Promoting interculturality, tolerance and mutual respect
 - o Increasing interpersonal skills and communication skills

o Discovering the power of constructive feedback.

Greece/ACP:

- Location: refugee centre
- Impact:
 - o Increased communication and language skills
 - o Exploration of new methodologies to learn and teach
